

March 30, 2025 – 4th Sunday of Lent

For too many of us, Lent is a season of doom and gloom, a time to feel bad about all the ways we are not “measuring up” in our spiritual lives. But this view could not be further from the truth. Lent is a season of refreshment and love, of awakening and rebirth. In fact, the word “lent” comes from the Old English word, “lencten,” which means spring. Lent is intended to be a springtime for us in our spiritual lives where all can become new again,

We owe God everything! But let's start by giving Him one little thing. Take even a faltering step closer to Him – go to confession, join in the Stations of the Cross, call a family member or friend you are at odds with and try to reconcile. With just the tiniest bit of spiritual “spring cleaning” we can be sure we will be swept up in our Father’s loving embrace and find ourselves feasting in His presence. That is what lent is all about.

LENT SCHEDULE

Stations of the Cross: Thursday at 6 PM April 3 - **SEAS** April 10-SSCM **GOOD FRIDAY- SA & SSCM.**

There will be Eucharistic Adoration every Friday of Lent following the 9am Mass until 11am at SSCM.

PENANCE SERVICES : There will be penance services at 6 PM April 2 - SA April 9 - SEAS

EASTER MASSES: Holy Thursday at 7PM (No Daily Mass) SA and **SEAS** Good Friday Passion (No Daily Mass) 2PM -SA 3PM- SSCM Holy Saturday at 8PM SA and **SEAS** **Easter Sunday** - Regular Mass times.

FIRST FRIDAY: Holy Communion will be taken to the shut-ins of the Parish on Friday April 4th. If you are unable to attend Mass for one month or longer, please call the Parish office.

Pick-up will be at the **(big brown doors)** at the 7th street entrance to our church hall. Please be on time when picking up your order.

LUNCH DELIVERIES will be offered to our local businesses in **the Windber area only!** Deliveries are from: 11:30am – 1:00 pm. Minimum order is \$35.00. For prep & scheduling, **all orders** must be received by 10:00am on Friday, No Exceptions!!!

FISH FRY PARKING: All volunteer workers, please use the church parking lots during our fish fry's. **Do not** park on 7th Street. Leave 7th Street parking for our patrons. Thank You.
