

April 13, 2025 – Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

We now enter a week in our liturgical year that is like no other – Holy Week. The complete name for this Sunday's liturgy is "Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion." Let us do our best to live this week closely connected to our Lord whose passionate love for us knows no bounds – culminating in His death on the cross and His triumph over death – all for us.

Stay near to Christ this Holy Week – attend the Triduum services of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday, pray the Stations of the Cross, increase your fasting just a bit – and allow yourself to be transformed by His passionate love, so that this week indeed becomes a week like no other.

LENT SCHEDULE

CHRISM MASS: Monday, April 14th at 11:00 Am at Cathedral in Altoona. (No daily Mass)

HOLY THURSDAY: April 17th Masses at 7:00PM at SA and **SEAS** (No daily Mass). The Church will remain open until 9:45 PM following the conclusion of Holy Thursday Mass. You are invited to stay or come back for quiet time, prayer, reflection with the Lord. Please remember there is no closing service.

WASHING OF FEET: A custom tradition at the Holy Thursday Mass is for the priest to wash the feet of parishioners to imitate the humility and selfless love of Jesus, who washed the feet of the Twelve Apostles. 12 volunteers will be needed at this Mass. If you would consider volunteering for this please sign up outside the priest's sacristy.

Stations of the Cross at 6:00 pm at SA and SSCM

HOLY SATURDAY: April 19th Easter Vigil at SA and **SEAS at 8:30 pm.**
